I propose you a tour of Montalcino with a visit to the abbey of Sant'Antimo, a wonderful pearl wrapped in the Val d'Orcia.

If you are self-guided and have a volunteer willing to guide you through the vineyards and barrels while remaining sober, I will take you to discover the world of Brunello through a tasting in a small winery that enjoys a spectacular view of Monte Amiata.
